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Description:

The Adult Literacy Program is intended, for the Gambian community residing in Louisville, Kentucky. After a brief survey within our community, we realized that most people within our community were unlettered, especially women. All these people are off age to attend the traditional educational system provided in the State of Kentucky. Therefore, the **Gambian Louisville Association** sees it as a necessity to facilitate an Adult Literacy program for those men and women that are interested to learn the basic skills of reading and writing. We consider the situation alarming as literacy is a crucial step to acquiring the basic skills needed to cope with the many challenges children, youth and adults will face throughout their lives

Objective:

The objective is to improve the resourcefulness of our community men and women by empowering them with the basic skills they need in searching for better jobs and helping their kids with homework and other literacy activities.

Framework:

The Intended Adult Literacy Program is divided into three phases. The first phase is scheduled to commence on **September 19th, 2021**, and end on **November 19th, 2021** (Two Months Duration). The classes are intended to be twice a week for a period of 40-to 45 minutes. (**Sunday & Tuesday** are the selected days).

Participants:

Participation is open to the **members of the Gambian Louisville Association** that are interested in Adult Literacy. This is in line with the fulfillment of the benefit of being part of the Gambian Louisville Association. The first phase would encompass a maximum of 10 students.



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Procedures:

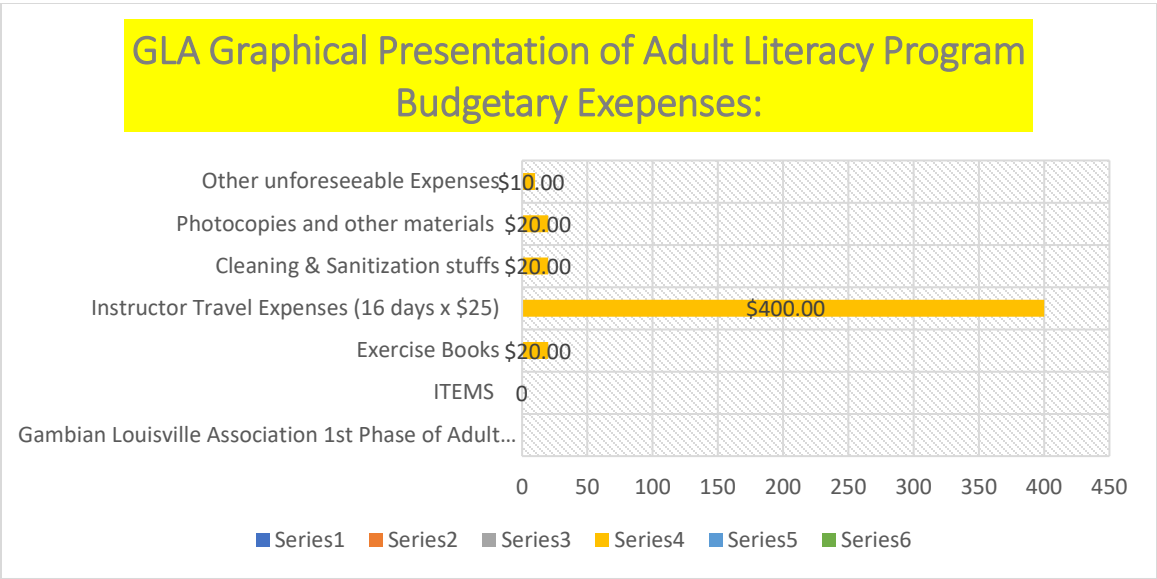
All the protocols of the COVID will be followed, and each of the participating students will comply with the stipulated guidelines.

Project Budget:

The first phase of the Adult Literacy Program would be sponsored by **Gambia Louisville Association**. The below is the breakdown of the expenses to be incurred.

Expected Outcome:

At the end of the program, **Gambian Louisville Association (GLA)** expects that 90% of adults enroll in the literacy program will be able to do basic reading and writing. Our general goal is to achieve a 50 percent improvement in the level of adult literacy within our community by 2025.

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Monitory and Evaluation:

The Gambian Louisville Association would establish a monitoring and evaluation team of four (4). These people are responsible for monitoring the effectiveness and efficiency of the adult literacy classes and report back to the organization executive.
